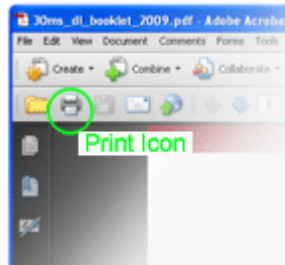


# 30minute-Seder™ Download Links and Printing Instructions

These instructions require that you have the latest version of Acrobat Reader installed on your computer. Getting the latest version is easy and it's FREE!

Just go to: <http://get.adobe.com/reader> to install the latest version of Acrobat Reader on your computer. It only takes a few minutes! Remember to restart your computer after installing.

Print these download and printing instructions by clicking on the “print” icon (in adobe acrobat).



## Download Your Haggadah:-----

- **Choose which format you would like to download.** You can download any or all 3 formats below (one at a time). Click on the link below each description to download the format you want to print.
- **When your download is complete, you will need your password to open the file.** Your password is located on your receipt above your download link.



### Easy... Print & Staple Format

The quickest and easiest format to go from print to Seder table. Each page is 8.5" x 11" and has 2 pages from the book version on every sheet you print out. There's no need for 2 sided printing. Both pages are displayed on one side.

### Large - Easy Read Format

Perfect for those members of the family that have difficulty viewing standard text, or for the leader of the Seder.

This download prints each page at 8.5" x 11" for an easy to read Haggadah.

This format allows for a folded two sided print version, just like the book version of 30minute-Seder™ sold in the USA. When assembled, the book measures 5.5" x 8.5".

## **Choose and download a cover. --- Standard or Personalized ---**

Print out the cover that is the same as our book (standard cover) or put your own family or organization name right on the cover & print a personalized version. Be sure and select the corresponding cover for the format (Print & Staple, Easy-Read, or Booklet) that you wish to print.

- **Do not begin printing until your download is complete.**
- **No password is needed to download your cover.**

## **Download Help for AOL Members:**

Check your email for your shopping cart receipt from [order@30minuteseder.com](mailto:order@30minuteseder.com).

On the receipt, in the area labeled "Description", you will see the product link(s) to your download(s); click on a link.

You may get this dialog box:

**"This link has been disabled for your safety.**

**To activate, click 'Show images & enable links' above."**

Click **"OK"**, then click on the link at the top right corner of that screen that says:

**"Show images & enable links"**.

Go back to the shopping cart receipt and click on a product link to get your download.

**Please note:** These files are large, so they may take a while to download. On occasion, AOL has trouble downloading large files and you may get disconnected or “timed-out”. Reconnect and try again. **If you continue to experience problems**, try downloading the files with a different browser such as Internet Explorer or Mozilla Firefox. “Take the link with you” by either cutting and pasting, or typing it into the alternate browser’s address bar (not the Google search bar”).

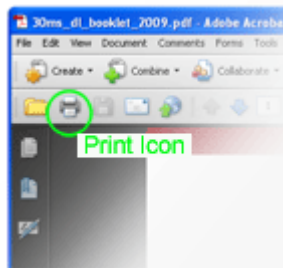
## **Printing Instructions:-----**

**These instructions will work with most printers, but printers vary; you may have to modify these instructions to work with your printer.**

**“Print & Staple” format:** The quickest and easiest format to go from print to Seder table.

Once your download is complete...

- **Check your ink levels before each printing.** We recommend printing out one Haggadah at a time.
- **Print your Haggadah.** Click the “print” icon (in adobe acrobat) to begin printing.

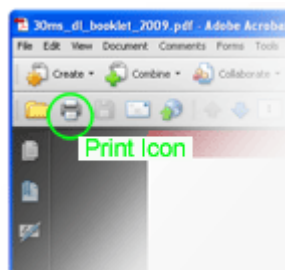


- **Print the cover.** If you haven’t already selected and downloaded your cover, please see the Download Instruction at the beginning of this document to do so. Click the “print” icon (in adobe acrobat) to begin printing. For a nicer finished product, use photo, or some other premium paper for your cover.
- **Stack in proper page order and staple upper left-hand corner. That’s it!**

**Enlarged “Easy to Read” format:** Recommended for those who have trouble reading standard print sizes or for the leader of the Seder.

Once your download is complete...

- **Check your ink levels before each printing.** We recommend printing out one Haggadah at a time.
- **Print your Haggadah.** Click the “print” icon (in adobe acrobat) to begin printing.



- **Print the cover.** If you haven’t already selected and downloaded your cover, please see the Download Instruction Section at the beginning of this document to do so. Click the “print” icon (in adobe acrobat) to begin printing. For a nicer finished product, use photo, or some other premium paper for your cover.

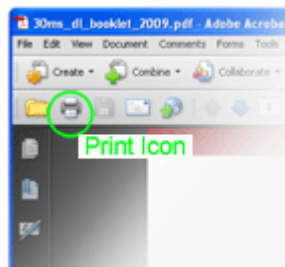
- **Stack in proper page order including cover, and staple upper left-hand corner. DONE!**

**“Booklet” format:** Prints on both sides of the paper. When done, all the pages are folded in half, collated, and stapled along the crease to make a booklet. If you think this might be too difficult or if you’re in a hurry we recommend that you download the “print and staple” format.

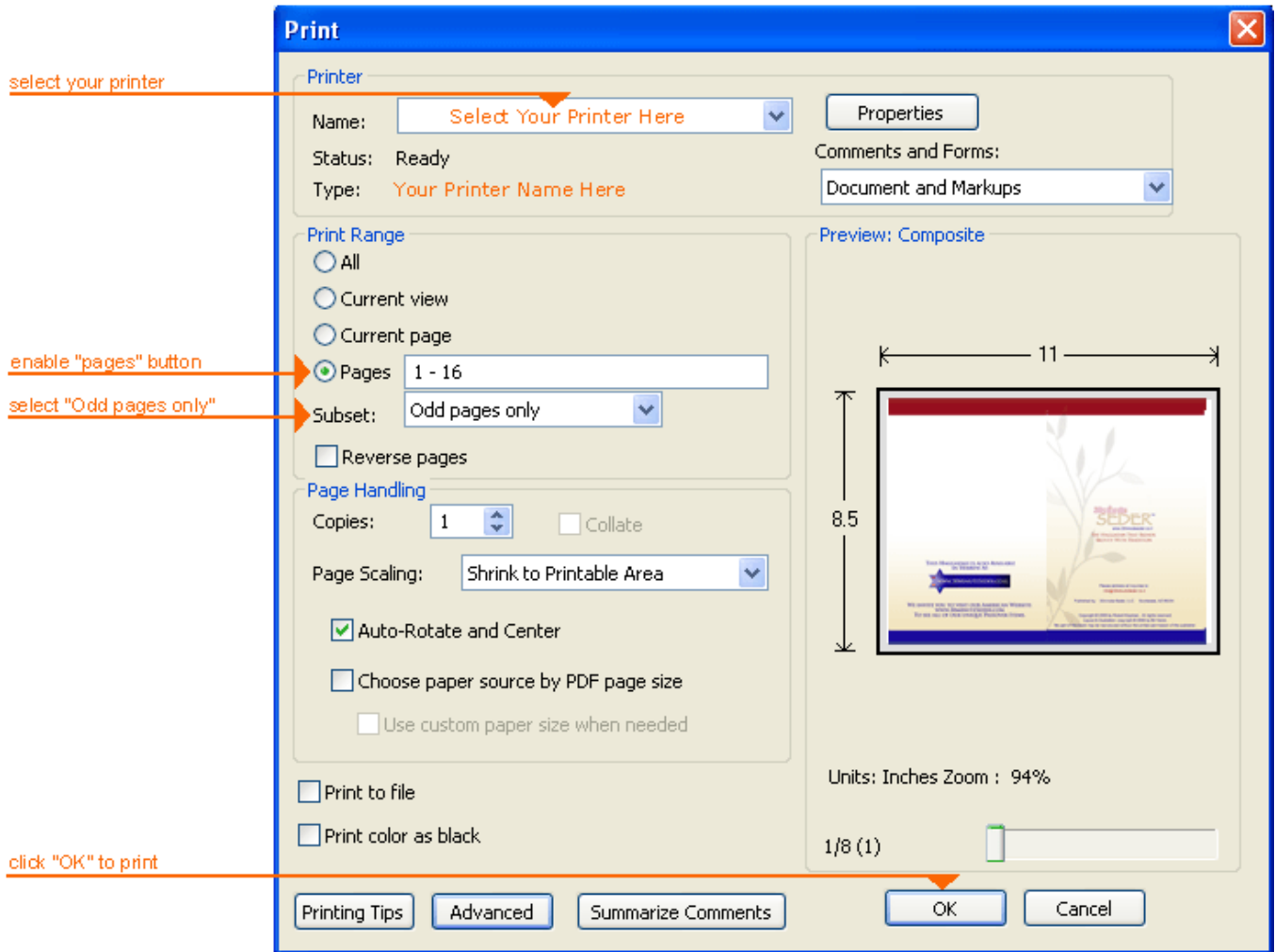
## For printers with a paper feed tray under the printer:

Once your download is complete...

- **Begin the printing process.** Click the “**print**” icon (in adobe acrobat) to begin the printing process.



After you click the “**print**” icon, the dialog box (shown below) will appear.



- **Print Odd Numbered Pages:**

In the “**Printer**” section of the print dialog box, select the printer you will be using.  
 In the “**Print Range**” section of the print dialog box, choose “**Pages**”.  
 In the “**Subset:**” drop down menu, select “**Odd pages only**”.  
 Click “**OK**” to begin printing.

- **Arrange the printed “odd” numbered pages in order** so that page 1 is on the top with the **printed side UP**. Then place this stack into the paper feed tray printed side up, and print.

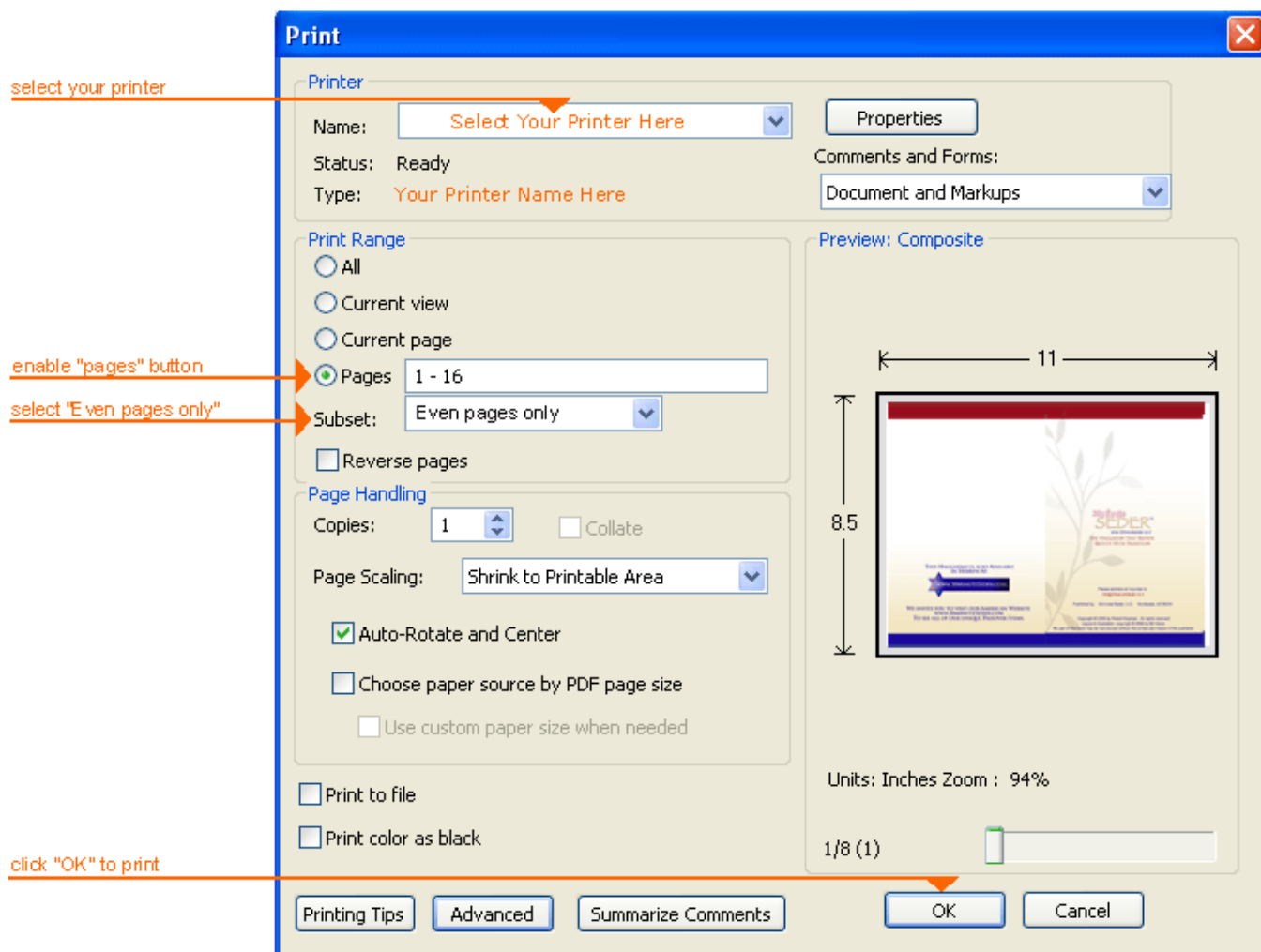


This is page 1.

**Note:** If you’ve never printed on the opposite side of a page on your printer, we recommend printing out a single page, (both sides) to ensure that the bottom of the page (the end with the Haggadah page numbers) is facing the same direction on each side of the page.

- **Print Even Numbered Pages.** You will be printing these on the opposite side of the odd numbered pages.

Click the “print” icon (in adobe acrobat) again to bring up the “print” dialog box below.



In the “Printer” section of the print dialog box, select the printer you will be using.

In the “Print Range” section of the print dialog box, choose “Pages”.

In the “Subset:” drop down menu, select “Even pages only”.

Click “OK” to begin printing.

**Fold all printed pages in half.** It’s easier to fold each page separately and then collate them in proper order after.

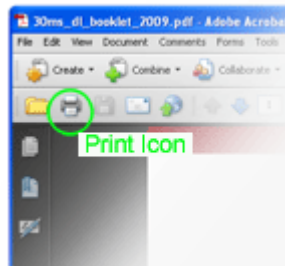

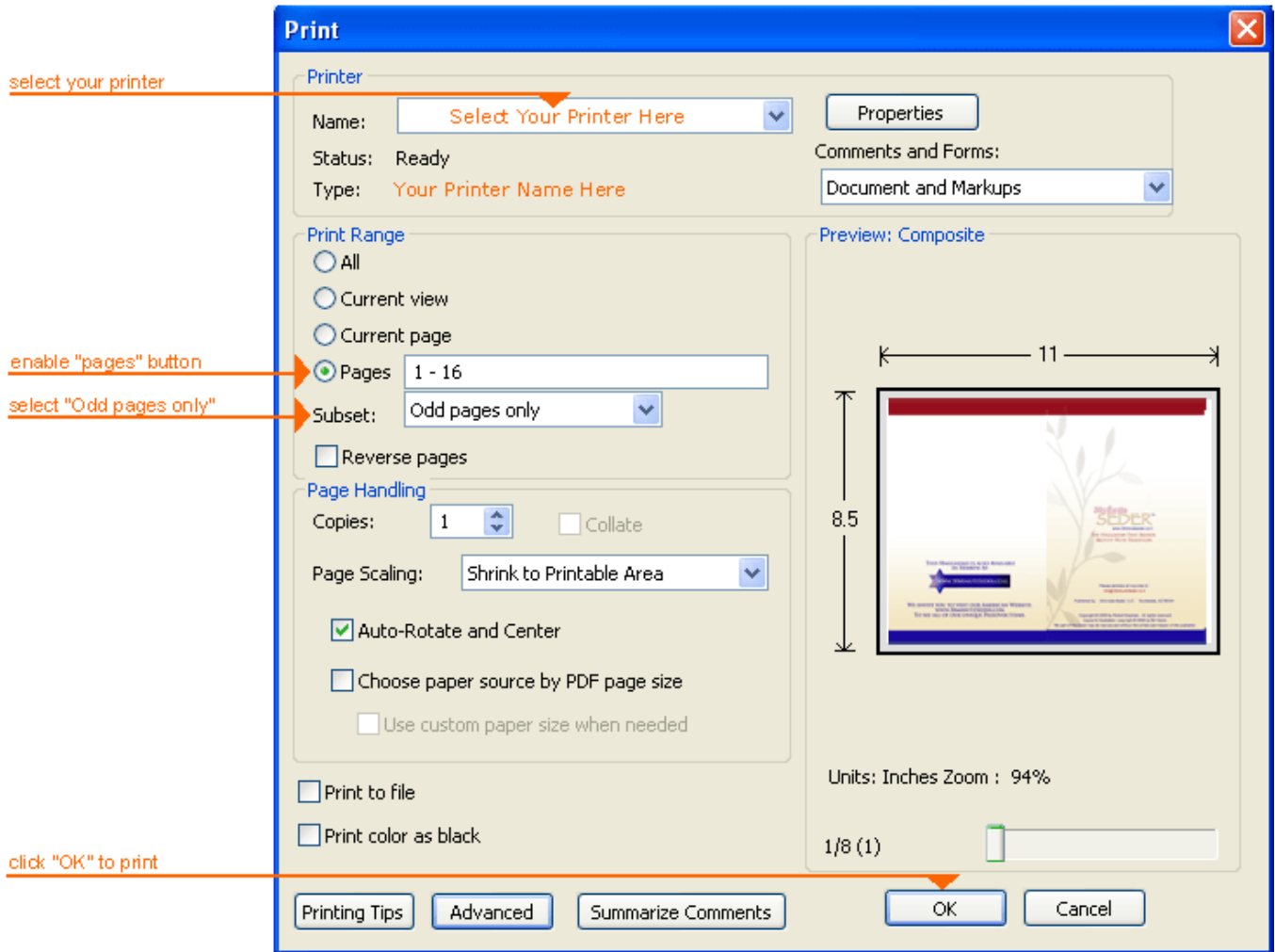
## For printers with a paper feed tray on top of the printer:

Once your download is complete...

- **Begin the printing process.** Click the “print” icon (in adobe acrobat) to begin the printing process.



After you select the “**print**” icon, the print dialog box (shown below) will appear.



- **Print Odd Numbered Pages First:**

In the **“Printer”** section of the print dialog box, select the printer you will be using.  
 In the **“Print Range”** section of the print dialog box, choose **“Pages”**.  
 In the **“Subset:”** drop down menu, select **“Odd pages only”**.  
 Click **“OK”** to begin printing.

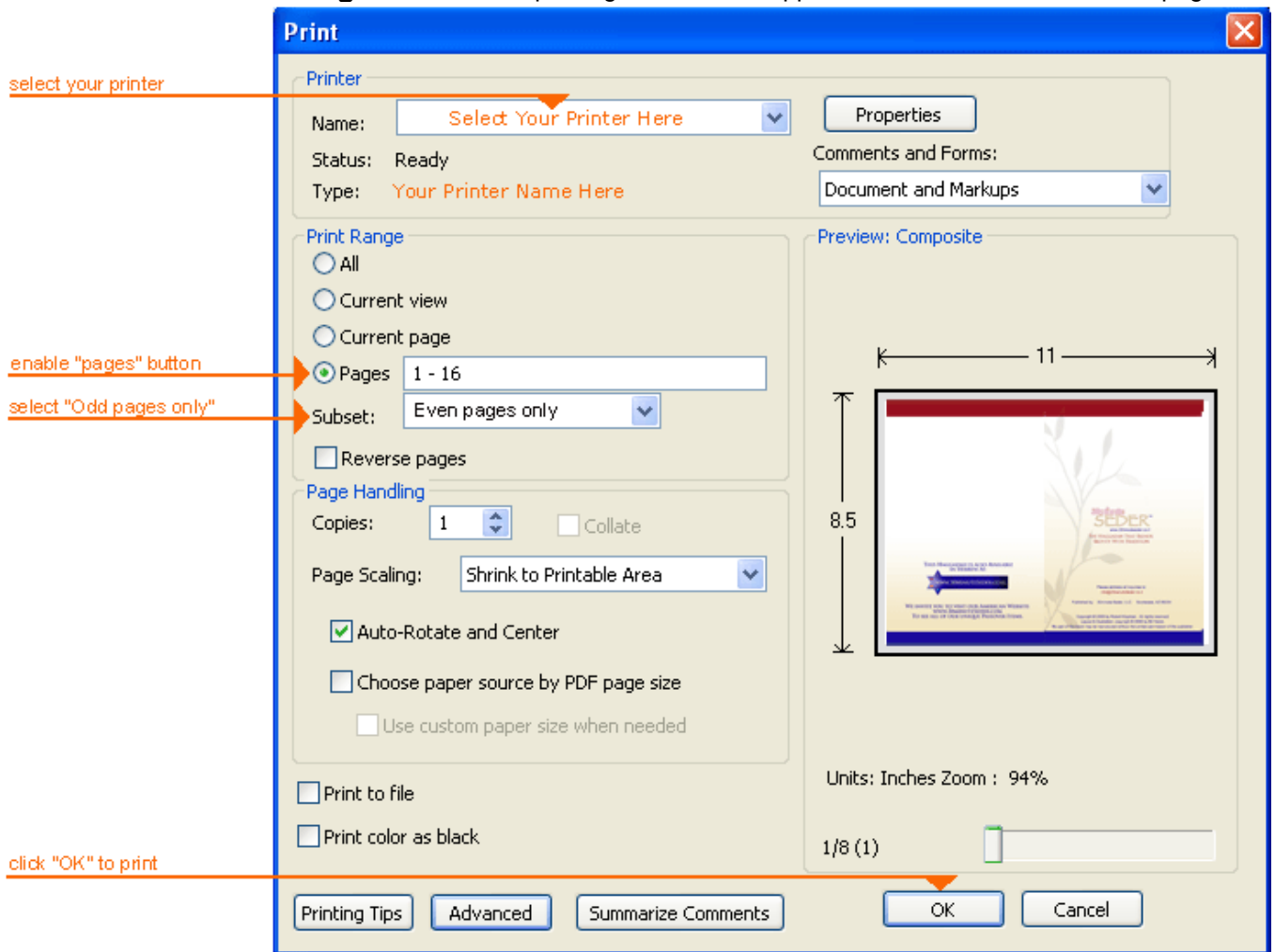
- **Arrange the printed “odd” numbered pages in order** so that page 1 is on the bottom with the **printed side UP**. Then turn this stack over so that the blank side of page one is facing up and then insert this stack into the paper feed tray (you should be ready to print on the back/blank side of these pages).



This is page 1.

**Note:** If you’ve never printed on the opposite side of a page on your printer, we recommend printing out a single page, (both sides) to ensure that the bottom of the page (the end with the Haggadah page numbers) is facing the same direction on each side of the page.

- **Print Even Numbered Pages:** You will be printing these on the opposite side of the odd numbered pages.



In the “**Printer**” section of the print dialog box, select the printer you will be using.

In the “**Print Range**” section of the print dialog box, choose “**Pages**”.

In the “**Subset:**” drop down menu, select “**Even pages only**”.

Click “**OK**” to begin printing.

- **Fold all printed pages in half.** It’s easier to fold each page separately and then collate them in proper order after.
